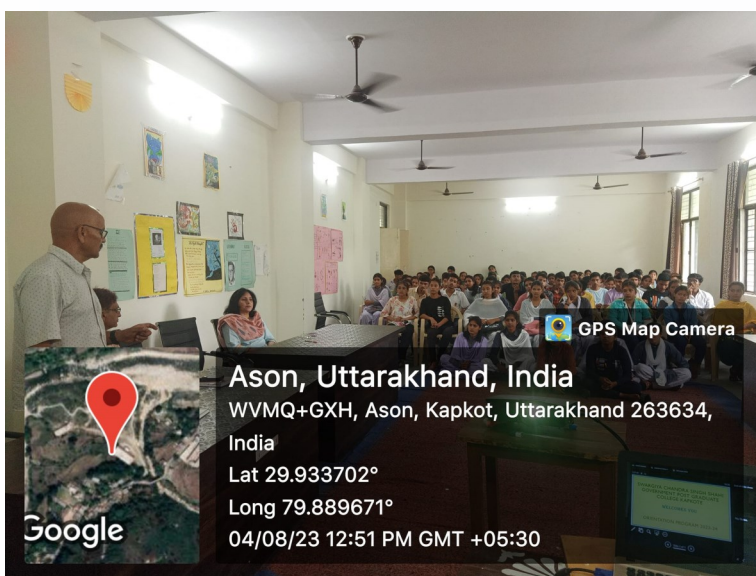

Sanskrit Department Program

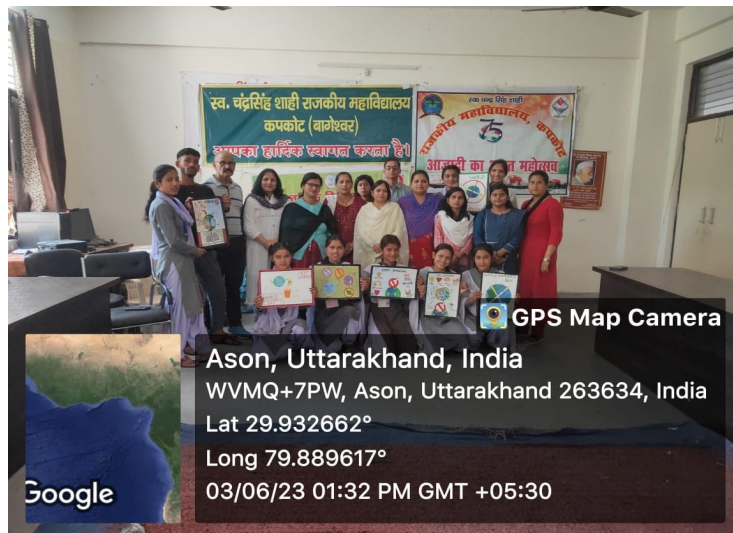
