











Observation:

Total respondents 153

88.8% students reported that they have smart phones to attend online classes

67.8% students reported that online teaching is not better than classroom teaching

96.7% indicated that study material provided by teachers in online classes is according to syllabus

- 100% students reported that teachers send their own audio/video lectures in online classes
- 51.6% students stated that around 70% syllabus has been completed
- 79.7% students suggested that whatsapp audio/video lectures are the most useful medium for online learning.
- 62.7% students stated that they attend online classes regularly.
- 58.2% students stated that they face network problem in their area.
- 79.1% students reported that they face power cut and weak network issue while online attending classes.
- 30.7% students stated that online learning are very useful, 66.7 % stated general and 2.6% stated not useful
- 97.4% students stated that their parents are aware about their online classes.
- 42.1% students have not downloaded the Aarogya Setu App.
- 98% students stated that they wear masks, use sanitizers and follow other measures to safeguard themselves against Covid.
- 50.3% students are in favor of online examination.
