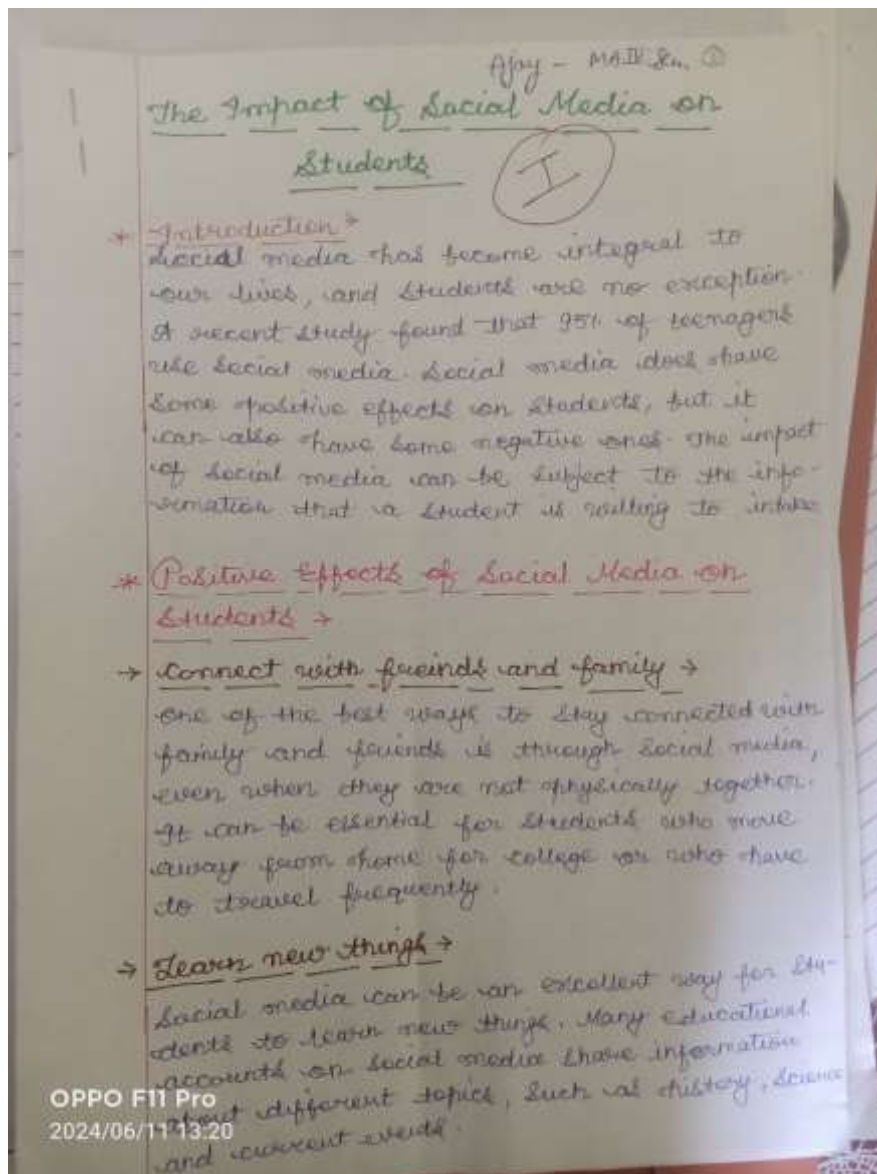
Activity 2
