Third National Service Scheme One Day Camp

Date 10 March 2024

On 10th March 2024 one-day camp of NSS volunteers was organized. Volunteers appeared in the college premises at 9 am. In the first session of the camp Information was provided to the volunteers about its establishment, objectives and contemporary issues by assistant professor Deepika Negi. Thereafter, an awareness rally was taken out by all the volunteers from the college to Ason village raising slogans related to environmental protection, drug de-addiction and voter awareness. The villagers were made aware by the volunteers about the importance of voting, forest fire and ill effects of drugs. Along with this, the work of cleaning the bushes on both sides of the road and disposal of scattered garbage was also done by the volunteers. Date: 13 March -19 March 2024

National Service Scheme Seven Day Special Camp

On March 13, 2024, a seven-day special camp under the aegis of the National Service Scheme of Late Chandra Singh Shahi Government Postgraduate College, Kapkot was inaugurated at the venue Rusa Bhawan. The program started with lighting of the lamp and Saraswati Vandana. Thereafter various cultural programs were presented by the campers. In the program Chief guest was Mrs. Shashi Shahi (Gram Pradhan, Ason), special guest Mr. Bhuvan Singh Shahi (former Gram Pradhan, Ason), Principal D.S. Negi, Program Officer Dr. P.K. Jha, Divya Pathak, Deepika Negi, all the professors of the college, student union and all the volunteers were present.



On March 14, 2024, on the second day of the camp, under Shramdan session an awareness rally was taken out by volunteers raising slogans and cleaning villages in Gaburi, Khadgera and Uttarauda. Under the intellectual session, Mr. Vinod Anand and Pramod Singh Negi from Azim Premji Foundation showed video clips related to women's issues to the volunteers and asked questions based on them. In the Shramdan session of the third day of the camp on March 15, 2024, a cleanliness campaign was conducted by the volunteers on the banks of river Saryu from the college to the block complex near Kapkot.
